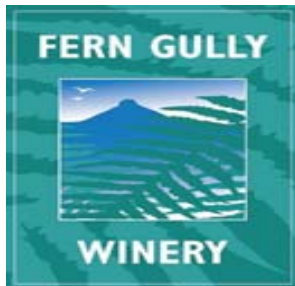

BEACHES

Jervis Bay beaches are world famous for their white sands and crystal clear waters. The protected beaches inside the bay provide a safe environment for all types of fun on the water and are especially ideal for families.

Some well know Jervis Bay beaches include Hyams Beach, Nelsons Beach, Murrays Beach, Collingwood Beach, Honeymoon Bay and Green Patch.

Featured below are some of the beaches that are very close to Bayside Retreat and also included are some of our favourite beaches around the bay that we recommend as well worth a visit.

HYAMS BEACH

Listed in the "Guinness book of records" as having the whitest sand in the world Hyams Beach is the most famous of the Jervis Bay area. The beach is family friendly as it doesn't get much swell but, like all beaches in the bay, it is unpatrolled. If you travel to the north end of the beach there is a rock platform with its own sandy beach - and a top snorkeling spot.

The famous white sands of Hyams Beach which curves around the bay for approx. 2.5 klms to Booderee National Park.

Pick your own private patch on this extensive National Park beach. Under the Marine Park zoning, line fishing is permitted along Hyams Beach.

MURRAYS BEACH

Murrays Beach is one of the jewels in the crown of Booderee National Park being located in a very protected bay sheltered by Bowen Island. Snorkeling is a must in the crystal clear waters of this sanctuary. As spearfishing is not allowed in Booderee NP, fish are unafraid of snorkelers and the sheer amount and variety of fish is astounding.

Murrays Beach is accessed via Jervis Bay Rd through Booderee NP. Car parking is in a large car park with a short walk to the beach via a bush track. Entry fees apply to all areas of Booderee National Park.

NELSONS BEACH

Nelsons Beach which is ideal for swimming, fishing or a game of beach cricket at low tide.

The kids will love this long stretch of calm safe water. The beach is also very popular for a sunrise exercise walk or a more relaxed family stroll at sunset .

At the northern end of Nelsons Beach is the extensive Plantation Point reef which is especially popular for snorkeling, fishing and spear fishing.

Directly behind the beach are picnic and barbeque facilities, playground equipment, amenities and a boat ramp in the Plantation Point Reserve.

The waters of Nelsons Beach and Plantation Point are within the Habitat Protection Zone of the Marine Park where line fishing and spearfishing are permitted.

SUMMER CLOUD BAY

Summer Cloud Bay or Aussie Pipe as it is known is a tricky place to find, and even trickier to surf. Take the road to Jervis Bay and then turn into the national park. You will need to pay. The car park is to the left just before you get to the private aboriginal settlement. Once there you will need to walk to the bottom end of the car park (towards the water) and along the track to the left about 800m. Please take your valuables because there have been break-ins at the car park before.

GREENFIELDS BEACH

Green Fields Beach can provide fun and relaxation for all the family. Pedestrian access to the Greenfield Beach picnic area opens directly off the cul-de-sac at the end of Elizabeth Drive, Vincentia. From the Princes Highway, take the Jervis Bay Road turn off and follow signs to Vincentia. Then follow Elizabeth Drive to the cul-de-sac at its end – there are parking bays along the road. It is a perfect picnic area equipped with electric BBQ's, toilets and showers. Also you can take the beautiful 'Whitesands' or 'Scribbly Gum' walk, which passes various beaches such as Chinamans, Hyams and Seaman's beach. This track is known for its superb bird watching.

GREEN PATCH

Green Patch Beach is located in Booderee National Park. There are two entrances; if you want to avoid paying the 48-hour National Park charge then you can take the first entrance to the beach. This area tends to be more crowded as the travelers try to avoid extra costs. However if you pay the money and go through the National Park, fairly quickly you'll see the sign to the beach on your left. The beaches turquoise waters and exceptional white sand are worth seeing.

BREAM BEACH

The waters of St Georges Basin are enclosed so no large waves ever form and swimming is very safe. The basin is popular with water-skiers who require calm water and fishing folk who are able to catch 4 pound flathead just 40 meters off the beach. The beach has grass within meters of the water and you can enjoy the beach all day by staying under one of the many gums that pepper the shoreline.

MOONEE MOONEE CREEK LAGOON

Moonee Moonee Creek lagoon is located in between Vincentia and Huskisson and is very popular with families especially those with young children. The lagoon has the most protected waters around Jervis Bay and they are usually extremely clear water especially at high tide.

This is the perfect place for very young children to play safely in the water or for older children and adults to learn how to snorkel.

Adjacent to the lagoon is a park with shade trees, picnic and barbeque facilities and amenities. You can access the lagoon via Elizabeth Drive or by riding along the waterfront bike/walking track that links Vincentia and Huskisson.
